



## **World Youth Day 2008/PROJECTeye – Position Descriptions**

National youth media organisation Vibewire, the people behind [www.vibewire.net](http://www.vibewire.net), sSquareOne, Reelife Short Film Festival, ElectionTracker, E-Festival of Ideas and the Interface Anthology are excited to offer some exciting opportunities to work in a team of young media makers reporting on World Youth Day 2008.

PROJECTeye is an online project developed to give a true independent youth response to World Youth Day (WYD), the largest single youth event in the world taking place in Sydney from 15th to 20th of June, 2008. Organised by the Catholic Church, WYD brings together young people from around the globe. WYD will be the largest event Australia has ever hosted. It will attract over 125,000 international visitors, more than the 2000 Olympics.

During WYD national youth media organisation Vibewire - in partnership with SBS - will communicate the voice of a generation and ensure that young people from diverse religious and regional backgrounds are heard. PROJECTeye will be generating a truly national and international conversation on diverse youth perspectives and opinions.

### **Logistic Volunteers**

10 to 20 positions

2 to 5 days a week from 7/7 - 21/7

The Logistics Volunteers will assist our team in managing our resources at the News Room and on the ground. This includes coordinating staff, equipment, promotional material and other resources. Logistics incorporates everything from knowing what events are happening, to who is involved, to where our physical and personnel resources are located at any time. Logistics Volunteers will be based at the News Room and will support the team throughout the week of WYD.

As part of the Logistics Team you will make a major contribution to the outcomes of PROJECTeye. Roles are quite flexible in regards to commitment and skills. You will need to be a quick thinker, show a keen sense of initiative, be motivated and proactive and work well under pressure.

### **Communications and Outreach Assistant**

1 position

3 days per week 23/6 to 13/7, 1 week full time (14/7 - 21/7)

In this role you will be assisting and directly reporting to the Communications and Outreach Coordinator. You will help preparing and distributing promotional material, investigating promotional avenues and tools, liaising with designers and assist with general communications and administration arising from the project. You will have to be a good communicator with excellent writing skills and experience in PR and/or marketing. You will be highly organized, pay great attention to detail and have a thorough, methodological approach to the job and your responsibilities.

### **News Room Coordinator**

1 position

2 days a week from 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full time (14/7 - 21/7)

As News Room Coordinator you will manage and support the editorial team at the News Rooms at sSquareOne ([www.s1.org.au](http://www.s1.org.au)) as well as the Accredited Youth Media Journalists on the ground. You will be ensuring the diversity of stories around World Youth Day. You will be coordinating content from both pilgrims and accredited youth media. Your main responsibility will be to edit and manage the final content published on our website, press releases and other forms of publications.

The News Room Coordinator will support the Multimedia Finisher and work together with technical staff. You will be liaising with other coordinators and you will be reporting directly to the Project Management Team. You will be quick thinking, highly organized and focused and work well under pressure. You will have the ability to manage a team and create a positive environment. You will be committed and able to rise to the challenge of this project.

### **News Room Editors (Written and Multimedia)**

8 positions

1 week full time (14/7 - 21/7)

We are looking for eight News Room Editors who will be editing written stories and multimedia content, and as such, you will be core member of this fantastic project team and you will be managing and editing user generated content for the project. Based on content provided by pilgrims and accredited youth media you will be working on a diverse range of news stories throughout the whole week of World Youth Day. You will have good journalistic skills and practical experience in editing content, written and/or multimedia.

### **Pre-launch and News Room Video Editor**

1 position

Casual until 20/6 (Pre-launch), 3 days a week from 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full-time (14/7 - 21/7)

In your role you will help editing a pre-launch video to promote the project and the website. During the week you will be collecting and reviewing field recordings and media. You will be working together closely with field journalists and the News Room team as you will be responsible for editing and uploading a daily video embedded into the site.

You will have substantial experience in multimedia editing and finishing and you will need to be focused under pressure, producing high quality work in a short period of time.

**News Room Multimedia Finisher**

1 position

3 days a week from 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full time (14/7 - 21/7)

The News Room Multimedia Finisher will be responsible for editing and uploading all multimedia content. In your role you will be reporting to the News Room Coordinator. You will be working closely together with a team of editors and the Multimedia Coordinator to ensure high quality multimedia content. You will have substantial experience in multimedia editing and finishing and you will need to be focused under pressure, producing high quality work in a short period of time.

**Accredited Youth Media (AYM) Journalists**

4 positions

3 days a week 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full time (14/7 - 21/7)

As one of our Accredited Youth Media Journalists you will have access to all media events surrounding World Youth Day 2008 and will be part of a strong, innovative team that reports the news as it happens, receiving support from the News Room Coordinator. You will be working next to professional journalists representing the voice of young Australians during World Youth Day. SBS will be sourcing material directly from the project during this period and all content could appear within its national media outlets.

You will have a passion for writing and excellent journalistic skills. You will be committed to providing content from the viewpoint of the young people involved in WYD, for digestion by all those who are not able to make the event.

**AYM Camera Operator (Film Crew and Pre-launch)**

1 position

Casual until 20/6 (Pre-launch), 3 days a week from 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full-time (14/7 - 21/7)

As AYM Camera Operator you will be leading an accredited film crew producing video content to be viewed on the project site. In the lead up to the event you will assist in creating a pre-launch promotional video. SBS will be sourcing material directly from the project during this period and all content could appear within its national media outlets.

You will have high working knowledge of professional quality video equipment. For the role you will need to have two years of university education or real world experience. The ability to work to quick turnaround deadlines will be essential.

**AYM Sound Operator (Film Crew and Pre-launch)**

1 position

Casual until 20/6 (Pre-launch), 3 days a week from 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full-time (14/7 - 21/7)

As AYM Sound Operator you will be part of the film crew and an editorial team. During the event you will be working closely together with the camera operator and field journalists. You will be editing sound for the pre-launch content as well as for daily video content embedded into the website.

For the role you will need to have two years of university education or real world experience. You will have a high working knowledge of professional quality sound equipment and software. The ability to work to quick turnaround deadlines will be essential.

**AYM Photographers**

4 positions

3 days a week 7/7 - 13/7, 1 week full time (14/7 - 21/7)

As AYM Photographer you will have access to all media events surrounding World Youth Day 2008. You will be part of a strong, innovative team of field journalists that report the news as it happens, receiving support from the News Room Coordinator. You will be creating photography for the website and to accompany text. SBS will be sourcing material directly from the project during this period and all content could appear within its national media outlets.

You will have to years of university education or real world experience in photography. The ability to work to quick turnaround deadlines will be essential.
